2. The financial assistance up to Rs.50,000/- to each is provided to the selected projects. The researcher (applicant) is expected to complete the project within six months of the approval\* thereof by TAI. The amount sanctioned is released in one or two installments, the first on approval\* and the second on successful submission of progress being made (from after a month of release of first installment).

3. The successful applicants will be required to provide Ethical Clearance of their institutions for the project. The approval will be subject to sending (before release of funds) a consent of the researcher that he or she will be able to do this research project within the amount sanctioned.

4. All medical students and doctors are eligible for submitting short term research projects. The proposed project must be forwarded/recommended by the Dean, HOD, Principal of the medical college/institution where the researcher proposes to conduct research. The project can also be forwarded through our State TB Associations.

5. The research proposals in the prescribed application form (downloadable from our website given below) duly approved/recommended/forwarded by the Head of the Department/Dean of the Institution, Principal of Medical College, State TB Association, Chief Guide, etc. (scanned), including the advance copy thereof, must essentially be uploaded on the portal on TAI website <https://portal.tbassnindia.org/>

6. The results/findings of the research may be used by the TAI for publication in its Indian Journal of Tuberculosis. So it may not be given/disclosed by the researcher to any one without the prior permission of TAI.

8. Last date for submission of research proposals is 30<sup>st</sup> April 2026. The final decision on grant of funds will be made by a committee set up for the purpose.
